#### From Chairman's Desk ...



Engineering for Change - A Roadmap to the Future of Engineering Practice, Management, Research, and Education.

Dear Engineers,

15 "September is celebrated every year in the country as "Engineers' Day" to remember the birthday of the legendary engineer Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. He belongs to that small band of eminent Indians whose ideas and achievements have been among the truly creative and formative force of modern India. He was a dreamer, thinker and a man of action who always thinking of the future, living an integrated life, bringing into existence and giving shape to dreams not for himself but for India and the people of India. His engineering projects really changed the scenario of engineering field and society also.

This year 'Engineering for Change' is chosen as a theme for Engineer's Day 2019. Engineering for Change is important thought in front of international community of engineers, scientists, non-governmental organizations, local community advocates, environmentalists and other innovators working to solve global development problems.

In this rainy season most of the part of India submerged in water due to flood situation. Especially this year Maharashtra suffered severe flood situation and strange climatic conditions. Monsoon has hit Maharashtra hard this year, not just because of excess rains, but also due to lack of it. While lakhs of displaced residents of Satara, Sangli, Kolhapur and other neighbouring areas are trying hard to gather their lives together after being hit by the devastating floods, the residents of the Beed district in the Marathwada region are reeling under severe drought-like conditions. Such is the rain deficiency in the Beed district that the dam supplying water to the people has nearly dried up.

Whether engineering fraternity can work together to avoid such calamities in future? Here the concept 'Engineering for Change' is having great importance and the role of technocrats becomes more significant. There is need of changed engineering policy for flood management. Flood management plans should be based on an integrated approach covering all relevant aspects of water management, physical planning, land use, agriculture, transport, urban development and nature conservation at all levels (national, regional and local). Decision makers at all levels, stakeholders and civil society should be involved in the development of the plan. A typical flood-management plan should look into the various aspects as- Integrated river-basin approach; Public awareness, public participation and insurance, Water-retention and non-structural measures, Land use, zoning and risk assessment, Structural measures, Early warning and advanced forecast systems, Flood emergency, measures; and Prevention of pollution.

Today there are many technological challenges before growing India. Powerful forces, including demographics, globalization, and rapidly evolving technologies are driving profound changes in the role of engineering in society. The changing workforce and technology needs of a global knowledge economy are dramatically changing the nature of engineering practice, demanding far broader skills than simply the mastery of scientific and technological disciplines. The growing awareness of the importance of technological innovation to economic competitiveness and national security is demanding a new priority for application-driven basic engineering research. Industry and political leaders continue to call for change in the way that engineers are educated. Future engineers need to be more than just technically competent. They must be able to refresh their skills continually to remain relevant in an ever-changing world while simultaneously being able to work effectively with diverse groups of people from a wide variety of backgrounds and expertise.

Modern engineers will require both commitment to change and investment of time, energy to change the future of world. Bold, transformative initiatives are necessary to reshape engineering research, education, and practice to respond to challenges in global markets, national security, energy sustainability, and public health. The perfect engineer is a composite. He is not a scientist, he is not a statistician, he is not a sociologist or a writer; but he may use the knowledge and techniques of any or all of these disciplines in solving engineering problems. Lets work together for changing the tomorrow for the betterment of society.
